The inaugural River Mile race was held in the Swartkops River at Redhouse on the 20th January 1924 and it was declared by all a huge success. Perhaps the greatest feature of the race is the fact that 48 men started and 44 completed the distance. Redhouse swimming club won the inaugural team race with Roy Gregory the first man home to become the River Champion. The Ladies Quarter Mile Race was first established in 1932 before becoming a Mile race in 1987.
